The two are brothers, associated with Gocha Mamatsashvili, deputy Minister of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection of Georgia. This TV company started its operation when Mamatsashvili was head of the local municipality.
Mega TV	Solomon Str. 7, Khoni, 5900, Georgia. Since 2006, this company has been located in Kutaisi	823521257	100% Kikabidze Merab. The owner is associated with Akaki Bobokhidze, an MP for Kutaisi in the Parliament of Georgia and member of the "Unified National Movement". He was a former representative of Khoni in the same position.
Metskhre Talgha	Rekvava Str 22, Poti, 4400, Georgia	24114	67% Zhvania Gela, 33% Todua Mamuka. He is director of Argonuts, chairman of the Georgian Nuts Exporter Association and a former vice-governor to Gorozia.
Odishi	Z. Gamsakhurdia Str. 19, Zugdidi, 2100, Georgia	821551771; 893306336	 70% Grigolia Emma. She is the mother of the head of the municipality of Zugdidi, 20% Kobalia Aleksandre. He heads the municipality of Zugdidi. 10% Kim Kim. He was adopted by Grigol Kobalia, the father of the head of the municipality of Zugdidi. The director of the company is a nephew of Emma Grigolia.
Rioni	Paliashvili Str.2, Kutaisi, 4600, Georgia	823151532; 41470	100% Ghvinianidze Tamar. She was appointed as a secretary of the "United National Movement".
